Sit with your back straight and your feet flat on the floor. You should arms next to your body in a comfortable position. Make sure the F at keys of the keyboard are immediately opposite the middle of your body. When typing, keep your elbows close to your body, wrists and foreat level. After striking each key return your fingers to their *resting* position the home row.



Proper Keyboarding Techniques





Touch Typing - is a style of typing without looking at the keys as you type. Although the phrase refers - typing without using the sense sight to find the keys. A <u>touch typist will know the location of the keyboard through muscle memory</u>.

Our number one rule is "Don't Look at the Keyboard"

Learn the finger for each key and memorize the location, the practice typin key while NOT looking at the keyboard.




