### *Proper Keyboarding Techniques*



- Sit up straight
- Feet flat on the floor
- **Body Centered on the Letters G and H**
- Elbows bent at side
- Fingers curved and resting on Home Row Keys
- **Thumbs resting at Spacebar**
- Eyes on your monitor
